John Todd. (1855-1943)

John Todd was born at Red River, the son of John Todd Sr.¹ and Madeline Ducharme. He was married first to Rosalie Desjardins, the daughter of Jean Baptiste Desjardins and Marguerite Hamelin in 1874 at St. Agathe. He was then married to Isabelle Bousquet, the daughter of Michel Bousquet and Louise Vendette in 1879 at St. Vital. She was a Treaty Indian from Battleford. For many years John was the mail carrier between Winnipeg and Edmonton.²
