## Louis Fleury. (1820-1897)

Louis Fleury was born at St. Francois Xavier, the son of Louison Fleury and Josephte (Grosventre). Louis was the brother of Metis leader Patrice Fleury. Louis married Marguerite Trottier,<sup>1</sup> the daughter of Andre Trottier and Marguerite Paquette dit St. Denis on January 10, 1843 at St. Francois Xavier. They had ten children. Louis Fleury died on November 26, 1897 at Fort Ellice.

Louis was one of the men who signed Louis Riel's August 6, 1880 petition to General Nelson Miles for a Metis reserve in Montana.
