Dear Mr. Morin:

Thank you for your letter of September 13, 1996 to the Honourable Joanne Crofford wherein you requested financial support for the administrative functions of the Metis Society of Saskatchewan. I have been asked to respond to your request on behalf of Minister Crofford.

We appreciate the early receipt of your 1997-98 proposed operating budget and have noted your request for core funding from the Province. As you are aware, the Metis Society of Saskatchewan (MSS), historically and currently, receives its operational funding from the federal government through Canadian Heritage and not the provincial government. The Province does provide funding to the MSS for activities related to the *Tripartite Process Framework Agreement*. Accordingly, your request for provincial core funding represents a significant policy departure for Saskatchewan. Nonetheless, your proposal will be thoroughly reviewed by the Secretariat as part of the provincial government's overall 1997-98 budget process and we will notify you as soon as a decision has been reached about the status of your proposal.
