You also have a recorded number of ballots for regional directors with one exception (acclamation) including a corresponding number of Declaration Forms which should result in an equal number of Declaration Forms and ballot cast.

VOTING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Indicate by a check-mark (✓) or (x) candidate choice for Regional Director.

2. A spoiled Ballot will be one that:
 - a) All candidates are indicated;

 - b) The (x) or check-mark lies between the candidate's name;

 - c) that is defaced.

3. Fold Ballot three (3) times and hand to DRO or poll-clerk.

BALLOTS

A rejected ballot will be one that:

- is marked with a 'Yes' or 'No'
- the candidates' name is circled
- one that is NOT initialed

A spoiled Ballot will be one that:

- all candidates are indicated
- the 'x' or 'check-mark' lies between the candidates' name
- if ballot is defaced or written on other than 'x' or 'check-mark'

Spoiled and rejected ballots should be placed in separate envelopes.
