D) All issues will be processed without undue delay. E) At any public hearing or sitting of tthe Judicial Commission, all Metis involved shall be tried in the presence, in their presence and shall have the right to defend themselves or appoint legal assistance of their own choosing. An application of the Judicial Commission must be made in writing outlining and detail the grievance or grievances. The Judicial Commission may by order approve the application and fix a time and place at which the Judicial Commission will convene a hearing. The Metis person who is not satisfied with the ruling of the Judicial Commission may appeal to the Senate and/or the MNLA. All decisions of the Judicial Commission shall be recorded and one copy sent to the MNS Head Office, Regional Head Office and one copy sent to the parties involved in the application. The power of the Judicial Commission shall extend to all issues brought before and shall be final and binding. The representatives on the Judicial Commission shall be elected from Metis people who are not Regional Directors, Presidents, Affiliate employees or Senators. And the representatives on the Judicial Committee shall be elected for a 3 year term.
