

**Paul, Bernard.** (b. 1848)

Bernard was born at St. François Xavier, the son of Jean-Baptiste Paul<sup>1</sup> and Angélique Godon. He married Marie Gervais at St. François Xavier and married Marguerite Trottier at Duck Lake. Marie was born in July 1849; her father was Basile Gervais (Métis); her mother was Françoise Ledoux (Métis). Her father and brothers were all active in the Resistance. Bernard's second wife, Marguerite was born in 1859 near Fort Ellice; her father was Resistance activist Joseph Trottier (Métis) her mother was Thérèse Vallée (Métis); she married Bernard in 1884 at Duck Lake.

Bernard Paul was a Captain of one of the 19 companies led by Gabriel Dumont during the 1885 Métis Resistance.
